

Sam Bomar Scholarship
(A Fund of West Tennessee Healthcare Foundation)
Requirements

One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior graduating from Madison Academic High School and one \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior graduating from another high school located in Madison County. Other awards may be made if funds are available.

Requirements:

- Accepted by either a two or four-year college or university in the state of Tennessee
- Public Service Major (e.g., Education, Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, Social Work, Christian or Bible Studies or the Ministry). If your major is not a traditional public service major, you may explain how you will use your education to help others.
- Minimum of a B Average (3.00) and 23 on the ACT
- The student's level of involvement in extracurricular and community activities will be given the greatest weight, especially scouting, church work, volunteer service, and creative arts activities (drama, speech, forensics, music, visual art).
